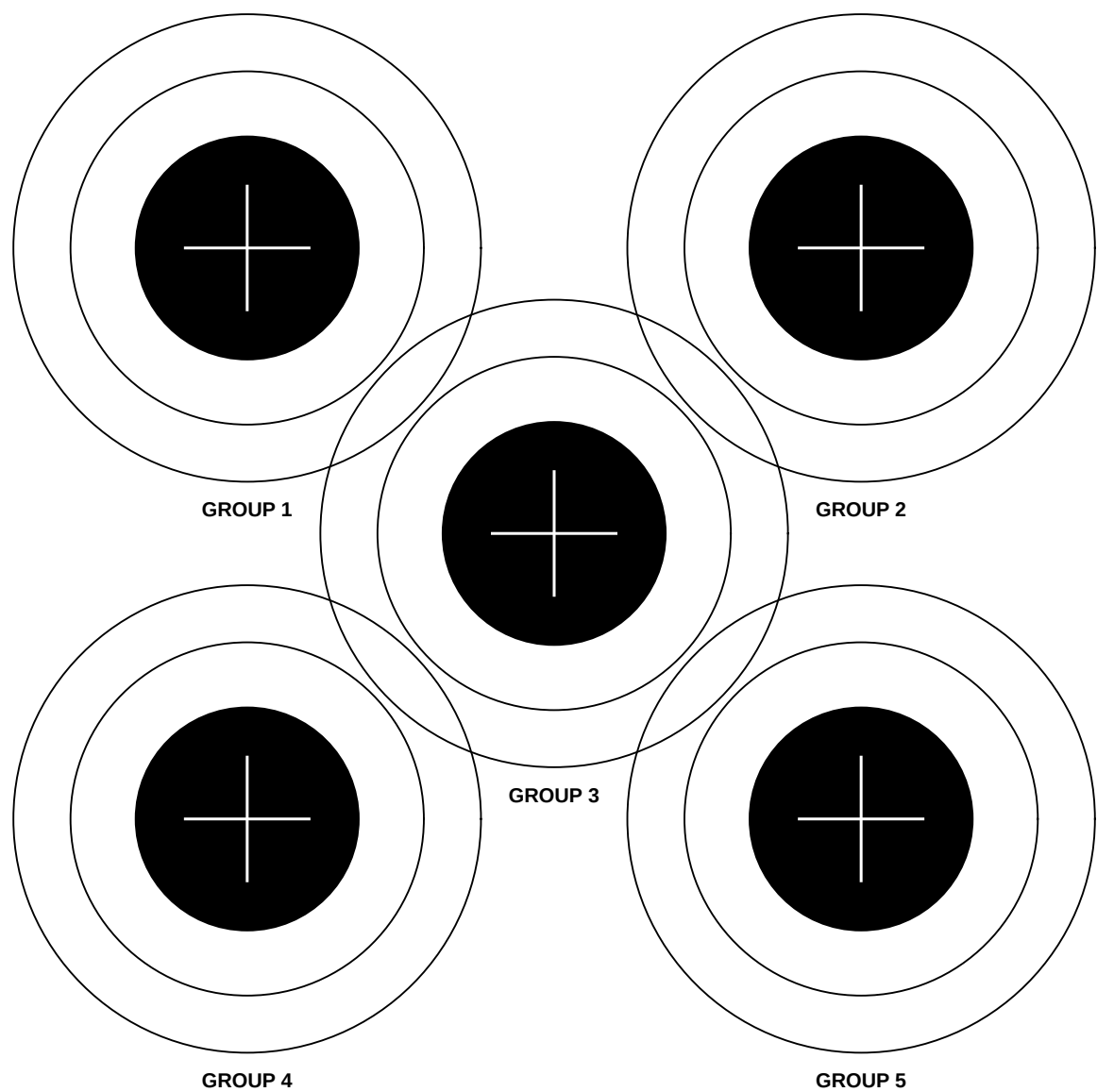


DIAGNOSTIC TARGET - group analysis

Five groups, one fault chart. No ballistic data - works with any caliber at any distance.



Right-handed shooter - mirror left/right for left-handed

Group lands	Most likely cause	What to work on
High left	Tightening grip / heeling	Relax support hand, follow through
High right	Anticipating recoil	Dry fire, ball-and-dummy drill
Low left	Jerking the trigger	Slow the press, break the shot by surprise
Low right	Trigger finger too deep	Use the pad, not the first joint
Low centre	Flinching / pushing	Ball-and-dummy, then live fire
Scattered	Inconsistent grip or sight picture	Rebuild grip, confirm front sight focus

Fire five rounds per group without adjusting sights. Read the group, not the individual shots: a tight group in the wrong place is a sight problem, a loose group anywhere is a technique problem. Diagnose technique first.

CHECK BEFORE USE - this bar must measure exactly 100 mm. Print at 100%, not "fit to page".
