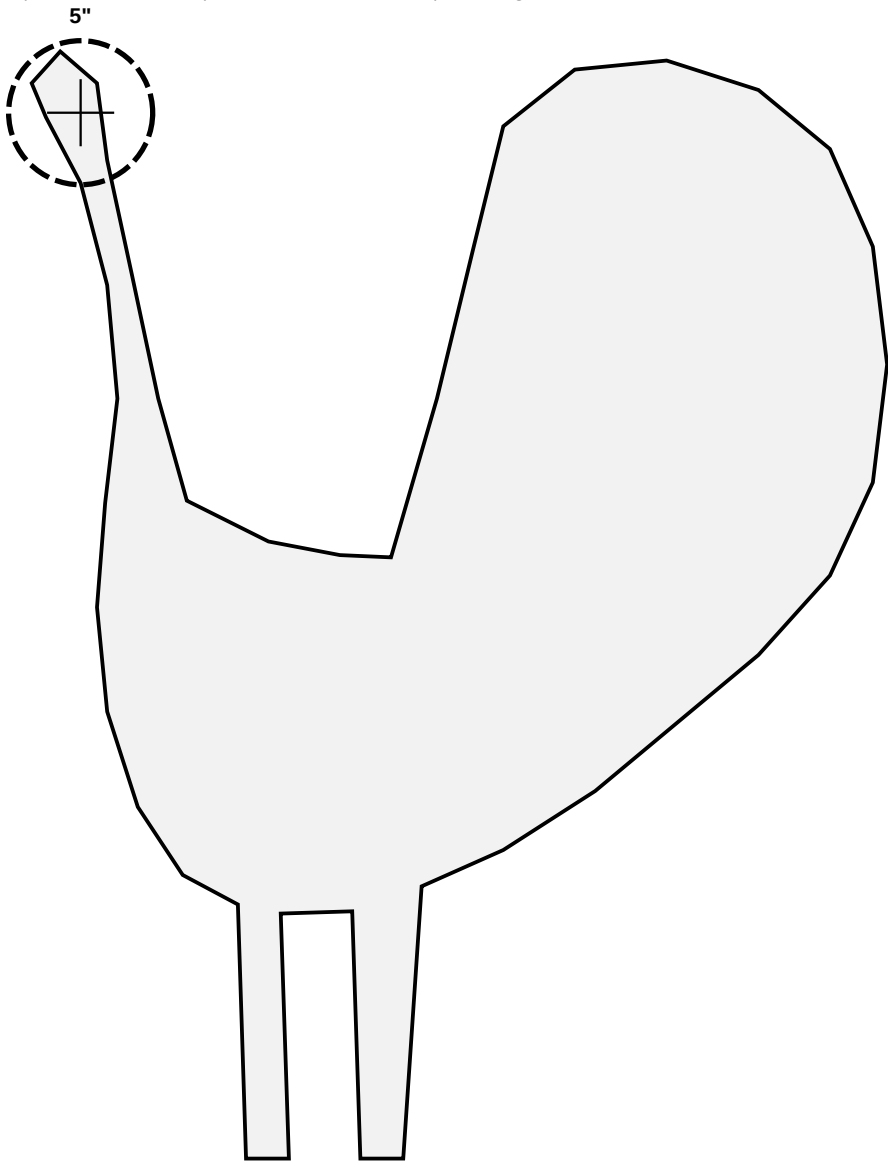


VITAL ZONE - WILD TURKEY

Broadside. Schematic outline with the heart-lung zone marked.

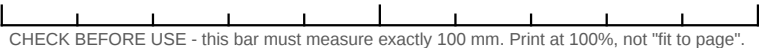
Reduced to 1:6.7 (full size 900 x 1000 mm) - this is a reference reproduction, not a full-size competition target



Dimensions

Vital zone	127 mm (5")
On this sheet	19.1 mm
Body, full size	900 x 1000 mm
Scale	1:6.7

Head and neck only, 5 in / 127 mm. A turkey's body is feathers over a small vital cavity and absorbs shot without a clean kill, so the head and upper neck are the only ethical aiming point. Body shots are not ethical on turkey. The circle is wider than the neck on purpose - it is the pattern you need to put there, not the outline of what you are hitting. Schematic outline, not an anatomical drawing - the zone is where to aim on paper, and the animal in front of you is the one that decides whether the shot is there. Reduced: measure the bar below before using any dimension off this sheet.



CHECK BEFORE USE - this bar must measure exactly 100 mm. Print at 100%, not "fit to page".
